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TOPIC: Firewall Security

The presentation given by Keith Grieshaber will regard global security management – including putting together a complete security plan. This encompasses environmental, personnel, physical and logical security. Also covered will be some of the pitfalls that companies run into when implementing security policies. Finally, Mr. Grieshaber will touch on such new technologies as Intrusion Detection.
