The presentation given by Timothy Ponstingle will regard computer data center vulnerabilities in the physical environment.

- Air Quality/Concentration Levels
- Humidity Control
- Energy Consumption/Waste
- Fire Suppression Systems' structural integrity
- Sub-floor (plenum) conditions
- Disaster Avoidance
- Adherence to OSHA Standards and State and City Codes
- Static Pressure
- Life Safety in the event of a disaster
